White Wine

- 1 Andes Peak Chardonnay - Chile** *Bottle £18.50*
Fresh and fruity flavours of ripe citrus fruits and a long lingering palate to finish. *175ml £5.50*

- 2. Sierra Grande Sauvignon Blanc - Valle Central - Chile** *Bottle £18.50*
A fresh and crisp wine with ripe citrus fruit. Packed with lime zest, lemon and kiwi fruit flavours. Think of cool glacial streams and enjoy the refreshing, racy acidity on the finish. *175ml £5.50*

- 3 Terrazze della Luna Pinot Grigio - Trentino - Italy** *Bottle £19.50*
This is leagues apart from your average, watery PG. Sourced from high grade Trentino vineyards this is a wine with real zest and vitality, lemon scented, crisp and dry. *175ml £5.70*

- 4 Sileni Cellar Selection Sauvignon Blanc - Marlborough - New Zealand** *Bottle £23.00*
The Cellar Selection Sauvignon Blanc has ripe tropical and gooseberry fruit flavours with a zingy finish and impeccable balance. The sort of delicious, fruity Sauvignon which made Marlborough so famous. *175ml £6.50*

- 5 Vetiver Rioja Blanco - Spain** *Bottle £20.00*
Intense fruit with hints of pineapple, meadow flowers and citrus, crisp acidity and a lengthy finish.
- 6 Domaine De Vedilhan Viognier - Pays d'Oc - France** *Bottle £19.45*
Sourced from a single Domaine in the Narbonne region of southern France. This is ripe and heady with an intense concentration of peach, apricot and pear fruits backed by a wonderfully zesty finish.
- 7 Orballo Albarino - Rias Baixas - Spain** *Bottle £23.00*
This classic dry white from Galicia offers plenty of fresh citrus fruit flavours on the palate and is very clean and light on the finish.
- 8 Domaine Talmard Macon Uchizy - Burgundy - France** *Bottle £22.00*
Domaine Talmard are an excellent Macon producer. This is a very clean and textural white Burgundy, with a fruity fullness of flavour that brings great depth to the wine.
- 9 Kim Crawford Sauvignon Blanc - Marlborough - New Zealand** *Bottle £32.00*
Award winning Sauvignon, packed full of tropical fruit flavours and a long zesty finish.
- 10 Domaine de la Motte Chablis - France** *Bottle £33.00*
Ripe lemon on the nose, the palate is well balanced with fresh fruit, remarkable elegance and great finesse.

- 23 La Grande Plage Rose – France** *Bottle £19.00*
This luscious and textural blend is very much a food wine, showing plenty of character and finesse. *175ml £5.70*

- 25 Lunetta Prosecco Brut – Veneto – Italy** *Bottle £22.00*
A deliciously light and fruity Prosecco with hints of apple and peach on the nose and a fresh, softly sparkling palate with characters of ripe stone fruits *125ml £4.35*
- 26 Stephane Breton Champagne – France** *Bottle £35.00*
Our superb house Champagne has a wonderfully soft, fruity style. Fresh and buttery, with the hallmark toasty notes gained through aging

Red Wine

- 11 Vega Piedra Rioja - Spain** *Bottle £18.50*
A great oak-aged Rioja. Soft and approachable with ripe berry fruit aromas, a rich and plummy palate with supple tannins and a long *175ml £5.50*

- 12 Last Stand Shiraz - Australia** *Bottle £18.50*
Rich, dark and full of flavour. This wine has plenty of spice and autumnal flavours of ripe damsons and plums. Nice and rich with a beefy concentration and style, full flavoured but soft and easy. *175ml £5.50*

- 13 Cape Heights Merlot – South African** *Bottle £19.50*
A bright and juicy Merlot with an attractively soft creamy, chocolatey nose and a palate bathed in dusky spice. *175ml £5.70*

- 14 Cabaret Frank, Old Vine Cabernet Franc** *Bottle £25.00*
A smooth medium bodied and easy drinking wine that strikes a lovely balance with its blackberry, plum and dark cherry fruit.
- 15 Ciconia Tinto - Alentejo - Portugal** *Bottle £21.00*
A medium bodied red filled with fresh red fruits and round silky tannins. Supple and smooth this is a lovely wine to drink with or without food.
- 16 Les Coteaux Cotes du Rhone Villages - France** *Bottle £20.00*
A fantastic wine that really manages to capture the soft, sweet and spicy flavours of the Southern Rhone. Fresh and concentrated with good depth.
- 17 Pablo y Walter Malbec - Mendoza - Argentina** *Bottle £22.50*
A very modern, fresh and fruit-driven Malbec with tonnes of ripe blackberry fruit supported by some vibrant, spicy notes on the finish.
- 18 Novas Cabernet Sauvignon – Gran Reserva – Chile** *Bottle £21.00*
Ruby red in colour. The nose is intense, with a pronounced presence of fruity aromas such as cherries and strawberries. Medium bodies, well balanced and delicate with smooth tannins, resulting in a juicy, pleasing wine with persistent finish.
- 19 Tierra Alta Pinot Noir - Chile** *Bottle £25.00*
A delicate and elegant Pinot Noir showing ripe fruit flavours of plums and wild strawberries, balanced with subtle smoky notes and a deliciously lingering finish.
- 20 Chateau Mayne Vieil Fronsac - Bordeaux - France** *Bottle £31.00*
Fronsac is a great value alternative to Saint-Emilion. A full and concentrated claret with intense black mulberry flavoured fruit and firm but smooth tannins, the ripe Merlot dominant fruit makes this very drinkable.
- 21 Amarone Riondo – Italy** *Bottle £35.00*
Accessible and delicious example of a modern style Amarone, rich and warming yet fresh and well balanced.
- 22 Ondarre Rioja Reserva – Spain** *Bottle £32.00*
A very fine Reserva made from a blend of the best selections of grapes that are then gently aged for 18 months in a barrel. Black cherry and redcurrants with spicy hints of cinnamon and tobacco.
